2017 TARIFF INFORMATION

There are three different types of bookings at Bishop's House: exclusive use, individual and group bookings. We also offer a self-catering option for the whole house throughout the winter.

Individual and group bookings are welcome during our Open Weeks. A discount of up to 10% may be negotiated for groups of 10 or more paying guests sharing rooms.

Exclusive use grants the use of the entire house regardless of their number; no other guests will be able to book into the house at that time. If there are other guests booked at the particular time requested, a group may still opt to visit during that period on the understanding that they will not have exclusive use of the house and will therefore pay the normal rates. We ask all groups taking exclusive use of the house to provide a Chaplain. The role is simply to take two services a day and be available to other guests if they wish to talk. The Chaplain needs to be ordained in a Christian church and be willing to take services in the Episcopal tradition, using the 1982 Scottish Liturgy. If your group does not contain a member of clergy who wishes to undertake this role, we can arrange for a Chaplain to cover the week. We will, however, have to house them in one of the bedrooms in Bishop's House, reducing the capacity available for your group.

Individual and group tariffs

Tariffs are VAT inclusive and per person per night.

Full Board – three meals a day and fresh afternoon baking £80

Half Board – breakfast and the evening meal £75

One person in a twin room may incur a £15 surcharge per night.

15% discount for clergy, students & children.



Exclusive use tariffs

Tariffs are VAT inclusive. Minimum period for all groups is three nights.

Clergy and Theological Students

October to March £1150 per night

April to September £1375 per night

Parish and other groups

October to March £1250 per night [when open]

April to September £1500 per night

DEPOSITS – A non-returnable deposit of one day's charge is required when making a booking.

PAYMENT FOR GROUPS – Due to losses incurred as a result of late cancellations in previous years, further payment of half the expected final account is due twelve months before arrival and a further 25% of the expected final account 6 months before arrival. Any adjustments will be made on the final account.

SPECIAL DIETS – Vegetarians and some medically supervised special diets may be catered for, please advise when booking.
